Dr. Jericho grew up in New London, CT, and completed the eight year combined degree program in Liberal Medical Education (PLME) at Brown University for college and medical school in 2006. She completed her pediatric residency at the Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh in 2009, and both her pediatric gastroenterology fellowship at The Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago and her Masters of Science in Clinical Investigation at Northwestern University in June 2012.

She joined the faculty at the University of Chicago later that year.

Dr. Jericho's clinical work and research have focused on a combination of cholestatic liver disease, nutrition, functional gastrointestinal disorders and celiac disease, for which she has produced multiple publications, including a number of peer-reviewed articles, and presentations. She founded the video capsule endoscopy program in 2013 at Comer Children's Hospital. Dr. Jericho lives in Chicago's South Loop with her husband and two children.
